SHSM PROGRAMS

A component of all four of our Specialist High Skills Major programs is a two credit co-operative education experience. Students will find a co-op placement linked to their desired career and will be immersed in the field related to their SHSM.

Specialist High Skills Major Programs Available:

Fitness and Health Promotion

Students in the Fitness and Health Promotion SHSM program gain certifications in CPR, First Aid, AED and WHMIS plus three additional student elected certifications.

Arts and Culture

The Arts and Culture SHSM program focuses on fundamental knowledge and skills specific to Graphic Design and Digital Arts. The program involves the practical and theoretical application of graphic design skills.

Business Leadership

Students in the Business Leadership SHSM program will develop problem-solving, teamwork, management and leadership skills in a business setting, and will take part in real-world business simulations.

Environmental Promotion

The Environmental Promotion SHSM program teaches students about current environmental issues and helps students to develop leadership skills while promoting change to better their school, their community and the global environment.
